

SECONDARY LEVEL STUDENT BUS DISCIPLINE

Minor Infractions – The bus driver and director of transportation will address these types of infractions.

Consequences will include:

- **Student Conferences**
- **Warnings**
- **Seating Changes**
- **Parent Contact**

If these infractions become persistent, the director of transportation will send a Bus Safety Report to the campus assistant principal. The report will include a summary of all previous actions taken by the driver and/or transportation director.

Minor Infraction Consequence Model for Campus Administration

- **1st Report – 2 days loss of riding privileges and parent contact**
- **2nd Report – 4 days loss of riding privileges and parent contact**
- **3rd Report – 5 days loss of riding privileges and parent contact**
- **4th Report – Loss of riding privileges for semester or year and parent contact**

Campus administration will work to consistently follow the model while maintaining the ability to use discretion as warranted.

Campus administration will immediately contact the transportation director to inform of consequence.

Major Infractions occurring on the bus include, but are not limited to; fighting, assault, possession or use of drugs or a vaping device, profanity directed at school personnel, or other major safety violations. The director of transportation will immediately send a Bus Safety Report to the campus assistant principal.

- **Major Infractions will result in a minimum of 5 days loss of riding privileges.**
