First Positive

1. A conference was held on _____ with the student, the student's parent/guardian, the designated administrator, the principal, the sponsors and coaches of the affected activities.
2. Suspension from competition or performance will be for a minimum of 21 school days.
3. The student and his or her parent or guardian with assistance from the athletic director or designated administrator must design a plan of action to prevent future drug abuse. The athletic director or designated administrator will present known options available to the student and parent or guardian regarding substance abuse counseling. A plan will be formulated and agreed upon by all parties. Prior to readmission into extracurricular competition or performance the student must present written documentation of substance abuse counseling. The cost of counseling will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian. If the student does not develop a plan of action or carry the plan out to its entirety, the student again may be suspended from competition and travel indefinitely until such plan is developed and is carried out.
4. The student will automatically submit a urine sample for drug testing for each subsequent random drug test for the next four testing times. If a student withdraws from extracurricular activities and at a later date wants to rejoin, he/she must complete the number of drug tests missed up to a maximum of four before being eligible to participate.
5. If the student does not submit a urine sample at any of the scheduled drug tests over this period, it will be treated as a positive test. If a student leaves school, without permission from the principal or designee, on a day drug testing is administered, it will be treated as a positive test.
6. Participation in competition, performance, and travel may begin on _____ if all the above requirements are completely fulfilled.

If a student withdraws from extracurricular activities and at a later date wants to rejoin, he/she must complete the number of drug tests missed up to a maximum of four before being eligible to participate.
5. If the student does not submit a urine sample at any of the scheduled drug tests over this period, it will be treated as a positive test. If a student leaves school, without permission from the principal or designee, on a day drug testing is administered, it will be treated as a positive test.
