Donna Clark, MSN, BSN, RN: School Health Update

- TCHATT
 - Telehealth visits for students with mental health issues that can be initiated by school counselors (and nursing staff).
- Respiratory Medication Policy
 - Epi Pen and Narcan Policies are already in place; respiratory policy is in progress so that stock inhalers can be kept on campus for respiratory emergencies.
- CATCH My Breath
 - To be completed at LMS; anti-vape curriculum is required for grades 6-12 in conjunction with Red Ribbon Week (October 23 31). Vape detectors at LHS have been installed to detect students using vapes in the restrooms (automatic DAEP sentence per state legislature). Nicotine vapes are a mandatory 5 day minimum at DAEP, while THC vapes are a mandatory 30 60 days minimum. Parental resources can be found on the CATCH website.
- Project ADAM
 - Program through Children's Health where campuses will have medical response teams in the event of an emergency. Once Project ADAM certified, campuses can receive money and grants for more AEDs.
