### Donna Clark, MSN, BSN, RN: School Health Update

- 3 new AEDs: two at LHS and one at the admin building, all campus administrators have been trained or are planning to train with the new AEDs.
- Narcan and Epi Pen Policies have been signed by Dr. Hay for implementation on each campus. One dose of Narcan is in the clinic, the SRO for each campus will be trained and carry a dose, and there are two located in the red Overdose Emergency Kit by the AED.
   Epi Pens are in the AED box, two pediatric and two adult doses.
- Drug and Alcohol Awareness to include Vaping Awareness
  - Mrs. Clark and Mrs. Kleppel have done a presentation for students at DAEP and are working on training LHS, possibly inviting presenters to teach on the subject.
- School Health Staff Newsletter sent out monthly by Mrs. Kleppel to include news and events in the district.
